PLANNING APPLICATION ON LAND ALONGSIDE THE BECKET SCHOOL ON WILFORD LANE

A considerable number of residents attended the consultation event in November at the Becket School. Cllrs Gordon Wheeler and Alan Phillips have been in discussions with Fieldsend Associates and also with Rushcliffe Borough Council planners and Highways at Nottinghamshire County Council.

Rushcliffe Borough Council are awaiting further documents from Fieldsend Associates. Once received, all of the documents will be validated. The application will then be publicised on-line and the consultation process will formally begin.

We urge residents to respond to the application, which has already generated significant interest, when it is on-line. Your views are very important to Gordon and Alan, who will carefully monitor all responses before submitting their comments. Do please feel free to contact either of them if there are any issues about the application they may be able to assist you with.

TRAM-SIDE PATHWAY, SAFETY FIRST

We reported in our October Newsletter about the concerns residents have regarding the motorcyclists using the tram side pathway through Compton Acres. We are grateful for the positive feedback from residents and were able to direct the police to some illegal motorcycle use. However we are still plagued with the ever increasing use by other motorcyclists using the path. After discussions with various stakeholders, we can confirm Rushcliffe Borough Council acknowledge the need to address these serious safety concerns. They have allocated funding towards works to change access and exit points along the tram path through Compton Acres, making it a safer place for all users once again.

Keeping West Bridgford in Rushcliffe
