KEYWORTH: BUNNY LANE CAR PARK

Keyworth Bunny Lane shoppers' car park was often full with long stay parking and it was sometimes difficult to find a space for an hour or so to do some shopping. To try to change this, the Conservative controlled borough council has introduced free parking for the first two hours, any longer parking periods are payable. Early indications are that this is proving to be very successful with more spaces being freed up for people to visit local shops, the health centre and local businesses.
