LOCAL HOMES FOR LOCAL PEOPLE

There is a target of a minimum of 250 new homes that need to be built on greenfield sites in Ruddington up to 2028, and the draft Local Plan proposes the following three sites are allocated for housing development



- Land to the west of Wilford Road (around 130 homes)
- Land south of Flawforth Lane (around 50 homes)
- Land opposite Mere Way (around 170 homes)

Ruddington's Conservative councillors have been listening to you. You have said that green belt land must be protected. We continue to campaign for a further reduction now that the planning inspector has granted the appeal for 175 houses at Asher Lane, even though the Parish and Borough Councils as well as we three councillors objected.
