

When you first elected me, Tina Combellack, as your Borough Councillor in 2009, for the then Nevile Ward, I vowed to promote Vibrant Villages in the Vale. Hickling, Hickling Pastures, Kinoulton, Owthorpe, Upper Broughton, Langar and Colston Bassett are all Vale villages and now make up the new Nevile & Langar Ward.

This has been aided by my work, for many years, as Chairman of the Community Development Group on the Conservative led Borough Council. I have also been representing Rushcliffe as trustee of RCAN (Rural Communities Action Nottinghamshire) enabling me to aid and advise communities on Rural grant funding.

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANS

Neighbourhood planning has been a topic of debate, bringing the shaping of neighbourhoods and communities closer to the residents.

I have been constructive in facilitating and guiding the Parish Councils appointed steering groups in their deliberations.

Three of the villages in the Ward, Colston Bassett, Hickling including Hickling Pastures and Upper Broughton are well on the way to submitting their draft plans for inspector approval.



COMMUNITY SUPPORT GRANTS

I have continued to help the residents of the local communities through the allocation of my Community Support Ward allowance

I have supported and sponsored the - Upper Broughton Art Show, provided maps for Hickling Scouts, kept the village clocks working in Kinoulton and Langar, helped provide an outdoor table tennis table in Hickling for the use of young and old and helped with local tree planting schemes.



Through persistent scrutiny of our policy on trees I have secured 10 trees for each of the Parishes, which will be planted and maintained by Rushcliffe in their first year.

KEEPING TIME

I have made sure the residents in the Parishes of Kinoulton and Langar are able to tell the time wherever they are in the village. No need for new fangled Apple watches - the Parish clocks now work well.
